Physical Education

In P.E we have partnered up with Kinetic Sports Group who will be teaching the children for one session each week based on Invasion Games where the children will be building on the skills they have already acquired and applying these in a range of games. The other session will focus on gymnastics where they will be focusing on balancing, creating shapes and linking the movements together.

Art and/or Design Technology

In Art, we will be looking at a global artist called Lascaux. We will be focusing on creating cave drawings, which will link closely with our history lessons. In Design Technology, we will be looking at designing and creating a product from 2D to 3D and learning the skills to go alongside this.

MUSIC

As musicians, the children will be focussing on a song called 'l've been to Harlem' and using this to explore and use pentatonic scales. In the second half of the Autumn term, the children will be focusing on composition and improvisation. They will have the focus of 'What stories does music tell us about the past?'.

MFL (French)

We will be exploring phonetics to begin with in our French lessons to build a foundation for the children. They will learn core vocabulary which will help them to construct and say sentences in French. We will then move onto learning the vocabulary for a range of animals. This will be done through interactive activities, rehearsal and independent work.

Computing

The Maples will be jumping into our computing curriculum by looking at computing systems and networks. They will learn the basics of how digital devices function, how devices can change the way we work and how we can recognise the physical components of a network. We will then be moving onto a more creative unit as we learn how to create media using animation. They will learn how animation is a sequence of drawings or photographs and how to plan and bring to life their own animation.

RELATIONSHIPS AND HEALTH EDUCATION

In RHE, our focus for the first half of Autumn term is 'Respecting Ourselves and Others' where we will look at the importance of showing respect to everyone, even when they are different to us. We will also explore the importance of self-respect and how this links to our own happiness. Our next focus will be on 'Families and Friendships' where we will explore the different types of families, why they're important and the positive aspects of belonging to one. Our final unit will be on Safe Relationships, where we will explore personal boundaries, safely responding to others and the impact of hurtful behaviour.
