EYFS Curriculum Information – Summer 2025

LITERACY

'Let's Investigate...' is based on a topic linked to Knowledge of the World. Through this topic the children's literacy skills will be developed through learning new language and listening to stories about animals. The children will also develop their literacy skills through writing about their favourite animals, designing and labelling a habitat, and making up stories about animals. They will write captions and simple sentences to go with pictures of animals and we will be focusing on capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

READ WRITE INC

We will be learning and reviewing new Fred sounds and special friends. We will continue to use 'Fred Talk' and 'Fred in your head' to blend sounds. The children will learn new 'red' words and will use these in their writing.


R.E

The children will explore the following question: What places are special and why? We will begin by considering places that are special to the children and our community and then we will consider special places for Christian, Islam, Judaism and Hinduism communities.









MATHS

The Willows will be looking at measures including length, weight and capacity. They will continue to measure and observe the length of the beans they planted. We will be learning about the composition of numbers from 6 to 9 and then begin to compare numbers from 0 to 10 and look at the difference between 2 numbers. We will then begin to look at patterns in odd and even numbers and doubles. We will use Numicon to support our learning of this and the skills and concepts will be reinforced within the continuous provision.

THE WORLD

The children will learn about the past by listening to stories and looking at artefacts that refer to the past and past events. They will think about their year in EYFS and how things have changed. We will also look at where animals live and their habitat. We will look at maps and how they help us with journeys.

EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

The children will explore making 3D props using different tools and techniques. They will also explore cardboard art and junk modelling, using recycled materials.

HOME LEARNING

Each week, children will receive home learning activities for reading, writing, and maths via Tapestry. These tasks are carefully planned to support and consolidate the skills they've been learning in school. Regular practice at home is important, as it helps reinforce understanding and builds confidence.
